We also may terminate the contract for any reason by giving you at least thirty days' notice in writing.

It is agreed and understood by the applicant that:

1. The Galena Territory Association and The Galena Trading Corporation are not responsible for the loss or damage to stated equipment.
2. The Galena Territory Association and The Galena Trading Corporation are not responsible for providing security for personal property, boats, or equipment stored at the Marina. Property owners are responsible to secure said equipment.
3. In consideration for The Galena Territory Association allowing me to operate, store and dock my watercraft upon The Galena Territory Association's common property, I, my heirs and personal representatives, do hereby release, discharge, indemnify, hold harmless and forever discharge The Galena Territory Association, The Galena Trading Corporation, and on behalf of myself, my heirs, and personal representatives, I agree not to sue The Galena Territory Association, The Galena Trading Corporation, their employees and associated personnel, officers, directors and agents. I, my heirs and personal representatives covenant and agree to indemnify, hold harmless and forever discharge The Galena Territory Association, The Galena Trading Corporation, their employees and associated personnel, officers, directors and agents from any and all present or future claims, demands, debts, contracts, expenses, costs, causes of action, lawsuits, damages and liabilities, of every kind and nature (including attorney's fees), whether known or unknown, in law or equity, contract or tort, that I may have arising from or in any way related to my operation, storage and docking of a watercraft upon The Galena Territory Association's common property, including claims resulting from or for negligence, both present and future.
4. The applicant has satisfactory insurance to protect the stated equipment, its contents or any accessories at all times.
5. Boats may not drive with motors exceeding 10 horsepower.
6. Boats and motors are subject to inspection by Association employees at any time.
7. The Galena Territory Association and The Galena Trading Corporation have the applicant's permission to move or relocate the equipment as it may require when it is not in use.
8. All boats and trailers must be registered and identified with Association unit/lot numerals and access decals and required state registration.
9. All boats must be removed from the water by December 1. Failure to remove a boat may result in the loss of docking privileges for the following year.
10. If a property owner does not house a watercraft in the slip for one full season, the rights to the use of that slip may terminate.
11. Renters may store additional watercraft in their storage pen spot, all watercraft must be owned by the same property owner and all watercraft must "fit" within that rented spot.
12. Applicant is required to provide proof of ownership for all registered watercraft on file with the Association office. Use of Lake Galena will be prohibited without appropriate documentation on file.
13. Owners of docked watercraft that can retain water are required to provide either a tented cover or a functioning battery-operated bilge pump for their boat.
14. Kayaks and canoes must be secured to the storage rack.
15. Loose items including but not limited to oars, motors, gas tanks, batteries, or tarps must be in or on a stored watercraft. Staff will dispose of unidentified loose items.
