It is agreed and understood by the applicant that:

1. The Galena Territory Association and the Galena Trading Corporation are not responsible for the loss or damage to the stated equipment.
2. The applicant has satisfactory insurance to protect the stated equipment, its contents or any accessories at all times.
3. RV's and snowmobiles will not be allowed in the storage area.
4. Boats may not have motors exceeding 10 horsepower.
5. Boats and motors are subject to inspection by Association employees at any time.
6. The Galena Territory Association and the Galena Trading Corporation has the applicant's permission to move or relocate the equipment as it may require when it is not in use.
7. The Galena Territory Association and the Galena Trading Corporation is not responsible for providing security for personal property, boats, or equipment stored at the marina. Property owners are responsible to secure said equipment.
8. All boats and trailers must be registered and identified with Association numbers and letter and with the appropriate governing body.
9. All boats must be removed from the water by December 1. Failure to remove a boat will result in the loss of docking privileges for the following year.
10. If a property owner rents a dock and does not house a watercraft in the dock for one full season, the rights to the use of that dock shall terminate.
11. If there is an "extra" boat stored in the storage pen spot, both boats are owned by the same property owner.
12. Applicant is required to keep a copy of their boat title (or current registration) on file with the office. Use of Lake Galena will be prohibited without appropriate documentation on file.
13. Fishing boats, canoes and sailboats are required to provide either a tented cover or a functioning battery operated bilge pump for their boat. If said equipment fails to prevent water from entering the boat, the boat will be pumped once for free and the owner notified to make repairs within two weeks. A fee of \$25 for the second pumping and \$50 for the third pumping will apply. After the third pumping, the boat will be removed from the water at a charge of \$150 and placed in dry storage. Subsequent storage fees may apply. Failure to pay fees prior to the next boating season will cause the dock space to be forfeited.
14. Effective September 27, 2006, when a member sells their boat to another property owner they do not have the right to transfer the use of the dock to the buyer.
